

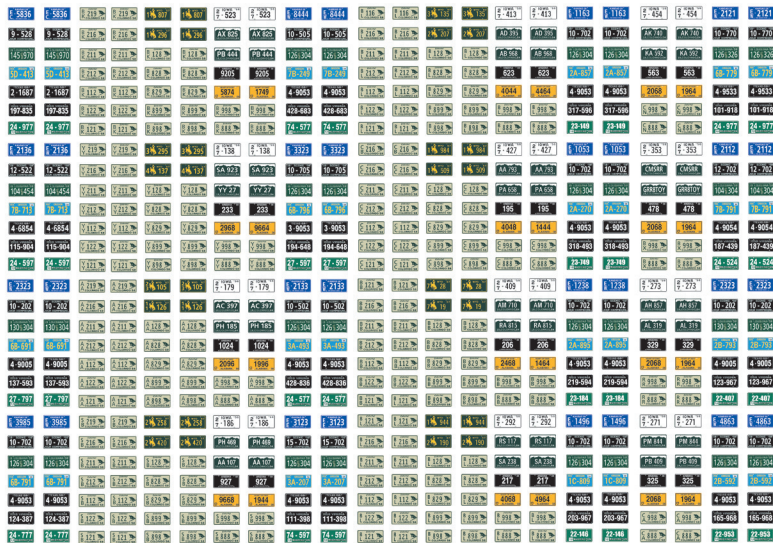

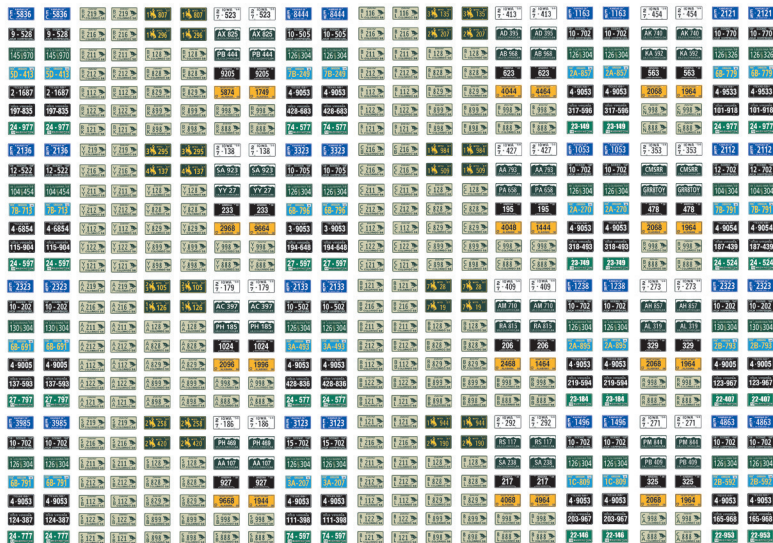
HO SCALE LICENSE PLATES

I created these license plates from images of real license plates from different states and eras. Numbers were changed to provide a variety of different plates. There are two plates per number for states that had front and back plates, but only one for states that I knew only used a single plate in the rear. The majority of plates are from Colorado (1958), but other states and years are also represented. You are free to print these for your personal use and may distribute them to friends provided no fee is charged. Printing on gloss (coated) paper works best.

Since it is important to trim these plates as close to the border as possible, I recommend using a metal ruler and a new X-Acto® No. 11 blade to cut out an entire row at one time. When making the vertical cuts to free individual plates use the blade like a cleaver rather than dragging the blade along the edge. — Randy Lee, Stationmaster
